## BRITAIN IS STANDING READY

### Nation United Against Aggression

POLICY HAS BEEN DECLARED

Quiet Confidence Is Based On Preparedness

INTENTIONS ARE PEACEFUL

Britain Offers Warships.

(Received August 21, 7.30 p.m.)

RUGBY, Aug. 21

Both the "Sunday Times" and "Daily Mail" support the unity of the British nation behind the policy which the Rt. Hon. Neville Chamberlain and Lord Halifax have recommended. The two papers are unanimous and constructive in discussion once confidence in the peaceful intentions of Germany has been established. The main result of our policy is to restore confidence in the peaceful intention of Germany.

The "Sunday Times" says: "This is a sound and patriotic policy. It will not, if duly carried, be a fatalistic act of self-sacrifice. The sum before us may be great, but the risk of war is small. We must be prepared, but we have the advantage over the men of 1914."

The "Daily Mail" quotes the same in its policy statement. In their view, the "Sunday Times" says: "We in Great Britain know well that if such a policy is adopted, the whole world will be behind us. In which case, our country would participate with all its forces. We are confident that we could win it, but we do not expect it to occur."

The L. J. G. Curtis, writing in the "Observer," says: "Our whole-hearted support of the policy of the government of the common people in the hour of 'severe awakening' is a sound and patriotic act. It is sound because it is based on the best interests to fear, it is patriotic because it is based on the greatest love for one's country, ready for sacrifice or death if necessary to protect our home and our hearth."

"Maybe we cannot keep out of the war, but we can at least do as we did in the First World War and split this one broad band for three or four years, and then, when we are strong enough to do so long when we finally do go in."




