Germany Expected to March to Her 1914 Frontier

MOBILISATION MOVES IN FRANCE AND GERMANY

British Parliament is Expected to Be Recalled To-morrow

London, Aug. 22. It is hinted in Dazig that directly the Russo-German pact is signed Germany will present Poland with a 24-hour ultimatum.

The Berlin correspondent of the 'Daily Express' is informed that Germany's minimum demands in the Polish conflict have grown past Dazig and the Corridor and now include all the territory that the ex-Kaiser lost to France for the war.

It is claimed that in the event of military conflict German troops would fight their way to the 1914 frontier and remain "on the defensive." Even conservative circles consider that this territory would be recovered within five weeks from the beginning of hostilities without plunging the whole of Europe into war.

It is considered in Rumania that Poland might well lay down her arms. The crisis is expected on Friday.

A Dazig message says that the Nazi leader (Herr Forster) addressing German jurists, said: "You will be able to say that you were the last body to meet in the so called Free City, which is nearing its end."

Herr Forster was in excellent spirits.

The correspondent of the Associated Press in Berlin writes that the German Government has issued orders to all Poles in Germany, including those with all Poland's neighbors, suggesting that men will oppose her by the decision to strike at Poland.

More Berlin Reservists have been called up suddenly.

The Polish Press has advised the public to store a fortnight's food against emergencies.

The British Consul-General has conveyed a message to British citizens in Danzig that while he does not wish to cause alarm, he thinks that the situation is such that they should leave Poland while communications are still good, unless they have special reasons for staying.

It is considered in Hungary that Poland's fate is sealed. The Western Powers are now unable to assist any small Powers in East Europe.

Dr Frank, at the same meeting, said that Herr Hitler by bringing Danzig into the Reich, would take the last of the neutral territory and would eventually and avert the danger of a war which might destroy the culture of Europe.

The British Associated Press says that had established Danzig no longer exist.

A message received at 2.30 a.m. states that approximately 400,000 French soldiers and officers have been called up, and it is expected that more will be mobilized to-day.

BRITAIN'S GAVE WARNING

The British Parliament, according to a London message, is likely to be recalled on August 31.

It is stated in London on high authority that the pact was a complete surprise to British Ministers. The Government's attitude is that it is a situation of the utmost gravity for Cabinet.

Crowds are gathering at Whitehall watching the Ministers come and go.

A Dazig message says that the German Foreign Minister (von Ribbentrop), accompanied by Herr Forster, is expected to arrive at Moscow on Wednesday.

It is explained that the German Government has made it plain that it is a political position, which they have agreed to defend.

WILL WARSAW NEGOTIATE?

London, Aug. 22. Amid the general surprise created by the announcement of the non-aggression pact between Russia and Germany, it emerges from German semi-official circles that its speedy conclusion has already threatened the long-standing tension between Russia and Germany.

The impending pact, it is claimed, will doubtless help to clear the international political atmosphere to the extent of making the "recruitment" Powers more cautious in their policy towards Poland.

The Berlin correspondent of the Associated Press says that semi-official circles are unable to say how the pact between Russia and Germany will affect the Anti-Comintern Pact, under which Germany, Italy, and Japan are pledged to oppose international Bolshevism, but it is emphasized that since hostilities have been foreseen, German and Japanese relations have been under consideration.

Recently, Poland's position appeared to be greatly weakened, for no matter what the Western democracies might now arrange, Poland could not expect help from the East.

The Danzig correspondent of the British Daily Press says that leading Dazig declared that the pact would undoubtedly hasten the realization of Dazig's demand to join the Reich. It would also greatly reduce the possibilities of war arising out of a solution to the Danzig problem.

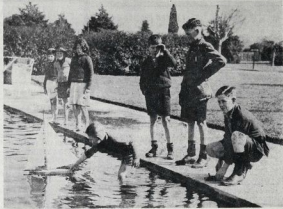

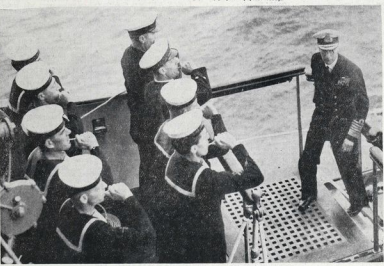

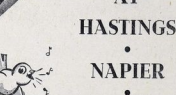
