Hitler's "Final Demands": Threat on Britain

WAR MUST BE ENDED NOW Vague Proposal For A European Conference

FARRAGO OF BOASTS, GIBES AND THREATS Return Of Colonies Demanded; "Germany Has Finished Begging"

BERLIN, Oct. 6. In his speech to the Reichstag Herr Hitler proposed a general European conference, to lay down arms and settle all problems at present agitating the nations.

"Should Churchill refuse this conference," said Herr Hitler, "then this declaration will be by itself. Churchill may be convinced that Britain will be victorious. I don't doubt that Germany will be victorious."

He asserted that he had no designs on Rumania, the Ukraine, the Urals or Denmark. He explained that the interests of East Europe, as well as Scandinavia, were purely economic.

He declared that the greatest boon for Europe would be an Anglo-German understanding, but he accused Britain of opposing all German interests, while Germany never crossed Britain's path.

"My God help so that my thoughts are understood, and so that not only Germany, but all nations in Europe, may enjoy peace."

"The most important German political demand is the return of the colonies. This demand is not an ultimatum. It should not be carried out by force."

"To achieve the end of continental peace the great nations have to meet in conference. This will need big preparations."

"It is impossible, however, to call such a conference under the pressure of war or even of mobilised armies."

"Since the problem must be solved, it would be reasonable to start the conference before millions of lives are sacrificed, but if necessary, we can reach the sea for there are no longer any lands."

"The fate of 1918 will not be repeated. I have no doubt of a German victory, but one thing is certain—never in history have there been two victors."

"Who should the war continue?" he asked. "For the restitution of Poland?"

"The Poland of Versailles will never rise again. This is guaranteed by Russia and Germany, by the action the final question of the Polish State will be solved."

"I plan moving the nationalities in Eastern Europe to avoid future conflicts in this area. Germany and Russia have agreed to assist each other in these efforts."

"Germany cannot be blamed if the demands of the return of the stolen colonies. I have refused to beg for the return of colonies."

"Great Britain had interfered in her own business in Poland, but had better in territories not belonging to her sphere of interest."

"The arable problems are the creation of a job and an arable amount from France, the return of Eastern Europe, the regulation of the Jewish problem and the creation of a Polish State which is no danger in this area."

"The revision of Versailles," he continued, "has created a basis of permanent order in Europe."

"Only those who hate this order can complain that it is not what they wish."

"If they hypocritically criticize my methods I reply that it is the methods, but stress that methods. Herr Hitler said that the world is in a state of confusion. The speech lasted for an hour and 30 minutes.

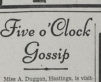

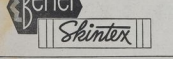
