ARE NAZIS PLANNING THRUAT AT HOLLAND THROUGH BELGIUM?
REPORTED PREPARATIONS FOR A LARGE-SCALE OFFENSIVE.
POSSIBLE MENACE TO THE SUZ CANAL

The Paris newspaper, "Le Journal" says that unconfirmed reports state that the German General Staff has decided to thrust at Holland through the Belgium provinces of Limbourg, and thence go northwards towards the Dutch ports.
The plan also includes a joint Russo-German drive on the Saar Canal.

The Copenhagen "Politiken" states that German officers and men have been recalled from leave, squadrons have been mobilized, and ambulance trains are leaving Berlin, indicating that an offensive is contemplated.

Broadcasts were interrupted for half an hour this morning. The reason is unknown.

A French communiqué says that the night was quiet on the Western Front.

British Press correspondents say that King Leopold and his Foreign Minister M. Spaak's arrival at The Hague last night and conferred with Queen Wilhelmina until 1.30 a.m. It is considered that the subject of discussion was either a possible peace offer or close co-operation between Belgium and Holland.

A semi-official report from Brussels stated that King Leopold III of Belgium is not connected with the proposal for a central coalition.

An official statement of Brussels concerning the proposed central coalition states that the King Leopold is expected to return to Brussels today.
