Holland Reiterates Her Neutrality

Flood-Water Protection Extended

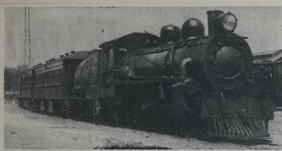

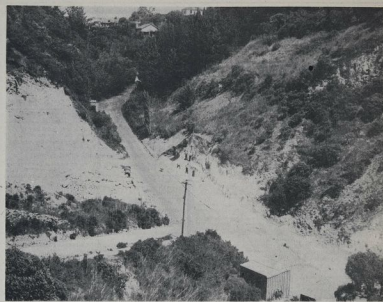

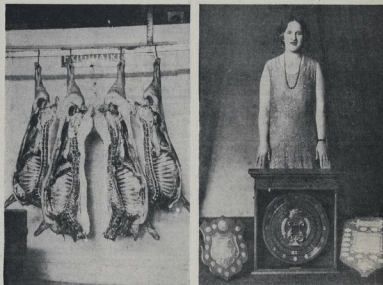

Considerable concern about the method of grading players adopted by Hawke's Bay cricket associations has been expressed by representatives attending the meeting held at Napier and Hastings. It was in an endeavour to clarify the causes of uncertainty and a certain amount of confusion that the meeting was convened. The meeting was presided over by the various representative players in the district. As far as possible the attempt was to interest players well versed in their teams who could have no personal bias in the matter. It was suggested that the players should be graded on the basis of the quality of batting or a side, and a player who was also on the sub-committee could thus represent its point of view. Nor was there any desire upon the good intentions of the associations in their efforts to improve the standard of cricket while giving every player a fair game. What was questioned was the advisability of the rigid grading system as it operated now. It was felt that it was not a fair system. The general opinion was that a fairer system of grading in the future should be based upon the ability of the players, and representatives of the sub-committee, in friendly discussion, do much to clarify the matter.
