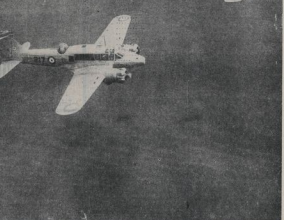
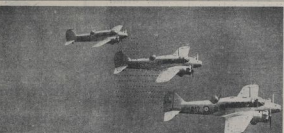

FINLAND WILL NAZI CASUALTIES ARE HEAVY, SAY NEUTRALS

Trains Full Of Wounded Frequent Heavy Losses In The Air

United Press Association—Copyright. (Received November 24, 10.10 a.m.)
LONDON, Nov. 24.
"The Times" Rotterdam correspondent says observers from western Germany report that the frequency of air attacks on the Baltic line is that the German losses are much heavier than is commonly supposed. Trains full of wounded are being sent to the front.
Reinforcements to the Siegfried Line are proceeding steadily and the fortifications are being extended forward to Cleve, on the Dutch frontier.

Six fell over the Allied lines and one on the German side. The British newspaper suffered no casualties, but one plane was hit and reported to land. Another was damaged.

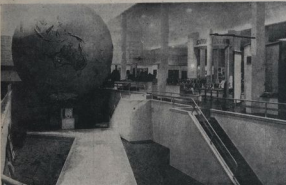

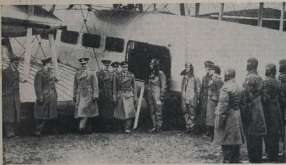

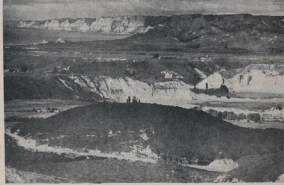
