Cornwall Handicap A Puzzler

(By MOTUROA.)

Although most racing folk in Hawke's Bay will be at Napier Park on Saturday, there will be many thoughts far afield—not at Ellerslie where the Northern meeting opens—but in the Century Hurdles at Wanganui and there is no doubt that this race has aroused wider interest than any other event contested at the River City in recent years.

Topping the list is that great jumper Clarion Call, who won the event in 1937 with 11.2. On this occasion he will have an extra 17lbs to carry, but that should not stop him as he is not only a great weight-carrier, but he has a penchant for the River City track.

Next on the list is that fine old horse from Greenmeadows, Curie, whose form at the Manawatu meeting suggested that he was as good as ever. However, with the going likely to be reasonably good he does not appeal as much as the Hastings jumper Soho, who beat him in the Rangitira Hurdles.

Student Prince has not raced since he won the two high-weights at Trentham in March and so he should be held safe by the improving Blue Tiger, who won impressively at Awapuni. Blue Tiger meets Soho on 6lbs worse terms, however, and he will need to improve to again be his master.

Old Surrey should be the pick of the remainder, though Brigadore should be more forward now than he was earlier in the season. However, this race looks like being a clash between four brilliant horses in Clarion Call, Curie, Soho and Blue Tiger and our vote goes to Clarion Call, with Soho the most likely to bring about his defeat.

WITH Jewelled Girdle and Baldrick accepted as staunch favourites for the Great Northern double and being backed down to very short prices, interest veers a little towards the Cornwall Handicap which presents an extremely open appearance. In this event anything should be at a good price.

Topping the list is last year's winner, Royal Appellant, who has a stone more to carry on this occasion. Royal Appellant has been racing more consistently than ever before and has added the A.R.C. Handicap to his bag among other successes. However, he failed at the recent Waikato meeting and he would need to improve on that form, despite his liking for the Ellerslie track.

Next on the list is the consistent, but unlucky, Gold Vaals. However, this gelding is a really good horse over ten furlongs. Gold Vaals seems to get none of the breaks, but he was an excellent second to Namara at Te Rapa and he now meets this gelding on 8lbs better terms. His chances, therefore, cannot be lightly regarded.

A SURPRISE PACKET CHEVAL DE VOLEE ranked as 14th favourite when he won this race two years ago, but he has always been a surprise packet and was at long odds on the occasion of both his Auckland Cup triumphs. For such a big winner Cheval de Volee looks exceptionally well treated here for he is sure to be improved by his race the second day at Te Rapa.

Namara is a greatly improved horse and it cannot be denied that there was a lot of merit in his President Handicap success at Te Rapa. He has 6lbs more to carry here, but he is in form and that must assure solid support for him.

Jack Tar is essentially a mud-lark. He impressed in winning the Whyte

Hot Box, on his day, is good, but he does not have many good days and one must necessarily place greater faith in Valmint, who has been the runner-up to Boomerang, Cheval de Volee and Royal Appellant in the last three Cornwall Handicaps. If this is not consistency then backers must be hard to please.

I have a lot of respect for Jayola, who won the Autumn Handicap at Avondale last year, but his lack of racing this season cannot inspire confidence and a better prospect would appear to be Erick, who won the Matamata Cup earlier in the year.

Erick stays on well and there is a disposition in some quarters to regard his prospects very favourably.

DUAL ENGAGEMENT LLANDAFF presents ante-post backers with a problem. He is also engaged in the Members Handicap and his recent work over short sprint distances suggests that this may be his mission.

However, this colt, who has won three of his four races in a row, which suggests that he is extra good, would be favourite if he contested the Cornwall Handicap. Furthermore, as there is no doubt

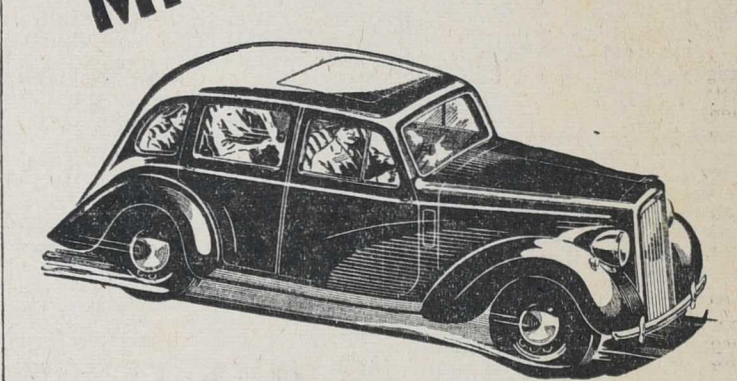
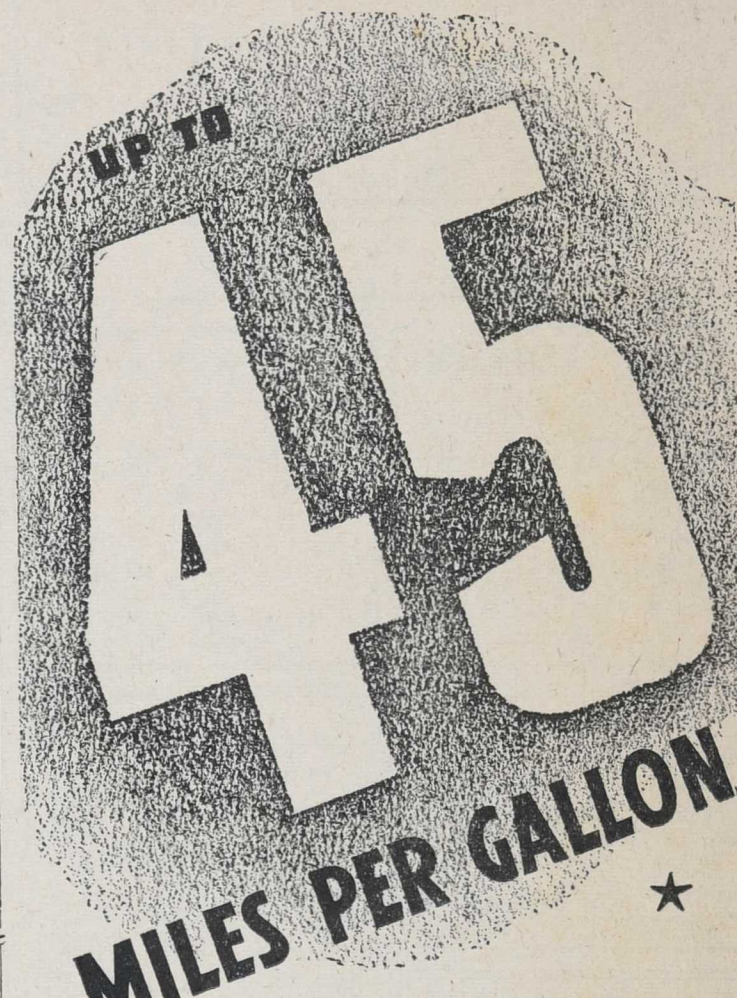
