
Love, love changes everything Days are longer, words mean more Love, love changes everything Pain is deeper than before

Love will turn your world around And that world will last for ever Yes love, love changes everything Brings you glory, brings you shame Nothing in the world will ever be the same


Off into the world we go Planning futures, shaping years Love bursts in and suddenly All our wisdom disappears
